## TABLET OPERATING POLICY

Approved by Library Management, January 23, 2014 Library Board approved revision, August 12, 2024

The Library reserves the right to terminate use of a tablet at any time if a library employee believes the tablet has been used in violation of policies or used in a manner likely to damage the machine. The Library also reserves the right to refuse use of a tablet to any person who has damaged library equipment in the past or used equipment in violation of Denton Public Library policies. Library customers are bound by the Texas Penal Code, sections 43.21, 43.22, and 43.24 which make display of obscene materials a criminal offense.

## USAGE PERIODS AND AVAILABILITY

Tablets are available on a first come, first served basis during library hours and no reservations are permitted. Tablets are for use inside the library only.

## LIMITATIONS OF USE

- Tablet use is subject to the Denton Public Library Internet Use Policy.
- Tablets should not be removed from their cases or their designated use areas.
- Customers will not tamper with the security settings or software on the tablet. Doing so may result in loss of library privileges.
- Personal software should not be downloaded to the tablet and no user files shall be retained in its memory.
- Customers should not add, modify, or delete apps from the tablet.
- Tablets are only available for use by specific age groups, as designated by the location of each tablet.
